1	Formstack Revisions on Risk Level Reporting- Committee to continue discussion on pt. risk level at the time of referral and revision of Formstack to create a separate column to track data for trend analysis— Sally & Bonnie to update committee on feasibility of reporting risk scores to HH alliance members. Committee to create a cross reference chart to integrate into corresponding risk levels of low, medium, high.	CMH and Dignity hospitals will be ready for rollout November 1st. They will communicate with us prior to rollout where in referral document risk level will be.
2	<b>UTI trend analysis &amp; PI:</b> Committee members agreed on tackling UTI. Discussion to look into available resources, CMS, HSAG, Hospitals/Rehabs/Agencies individual efforts. The idea is to see if we are able to <b>create standards of care</b> to implement best practices for every agency to follow.
